# STAR OF TEXAS ADULT OPEN

### RULES AND CONDUCT OF THE COMPETITION

The Star of Texas Adult Open will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of US Figure Skating, as set forth in The [2010 Official US Figure Skating Rulebook](#), unless otherwise stated in this announcement. This competition will be judged using the 6.0 system.

### General Information

#### ELIGIBILITY

The competition is open to all skaters who are 18 years old or older as of the entry due date. Competitors must be members of US Figure Skating, another national association (per rules 3055-3057), or Ice Skating Institute. It is the responsibility of members of non-US national associations to verify that association approves participation in this event. Skaters must compete in events according to their age and test level as of December 19, 2009. Competitors in singles free skate events may skate at one level higher than their test level. Competitors in partner events may skate at one level higher than the test level of the lowest partner.

#### ENTRIES / DEADLINE / REFUNDS

Competition entries must be postmarked by Friday, December 19, 2009. Metered mail is not accepted as proof of postage. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the competition committee but must include a late fee of \$50. At the Referee's discretion, men and women may be combined into a single event, and events may be divided, combined, or cancelled. The competition committee reserves the right to limit entries to any event or to cancel an event based upon time restrictions. Entry fees will not be refunded after December 19, 2009, the entry deadline, unless (1) no competition exists in the event(s) entered, or (2) there is a death in the immediate family. **There will be a \$25 processing fee for ALL withdrawals. There will be a \$30 service charge for returned checks, and payment by money order or cash will be required for returned checks.**

#### EVENTS / FEES

*SINGLES EVENTS: Free Skating, Interpretive, Extemporaneous Improvisation, Solo Dance, Compulsory Moves, Spins Only, Jumps Only* - \$80 for 1st individual event; \$40 for each additional individual event.

*PARTNER EVENTS: Pairs Free Skate, Couples Dance, Original Dance, Interpretive Pairs (mixed or similar)* - \$40 per person for 1st event; \$20 per person for each additional partner event.

*CHANGES TO EVENT REGISTRATION:* There is a \$25 fee for incorrect event entry information that needs to be changed after the entry deadline.

#### AWARDS

In all events medals will be given to the first, second, third, and fourth placements. Awards will be presented off-ice throughout the event.

#### FACILITIES

The Star of Texas Adult Open will be held at the Sharpstown Ice Center, 7300 Bellerive, Houston, TX 77036. The rink surface is 200' X 85' with rounded corners.

#### REGISTRATION DESK

All entrants are required to register at least one hour before their scheduled event. The registration desk will be open at the rink on Saturday, February 13, 2010, beginning at least 1 hour before the start of the first event until one hour before the start of the last event. A tentative schedule will be posted at the rink and on the club web site. Skaters are required to check the official bulletin board at the rink for the scheduled events. The Referee may begin the competition events up to 30 minutes early. The posting of such notices, changes or announcements shall be considered sufficient notice to competitors.

## MUSIC

Program music must be on a regular sized CD's (no MP3) and must be clearly marked with the skater's name, event, and running time of the music. The official competition CD recorded at an adequate volume must be turned in at the Registration Table at the time of check-in. An individual competition CD must be submitted for each event entered requiring music. Only 1 song should be on a CD. **A duplicate CD** will be needed for use during practice ice sessions and should be readily available at event time. CD's may be picked up at the Registration Table following each event. Every reasonable care will be taken, but the Iceland Figure Skating Club cannot accept responsibility for CD's. Music must be on **CD's only**.

## PRACTICE ICE

A limited amount of practice ice will be available before and during the competition beginning Saturday, FEBRUARY 13, 2010. Practice ice may be available on Friday night, depending on demand. Rates are \$10 per 30-minute session for advanced reservations. To reserve practice ice, please complete the enclosed Practice Ice Reservation Form and return it with payment by December 19, 2009. If available, additional 30 minute practice ice sessions can be purchased on a first-come, first-serve basis at the Registration Table when you check-in at a rate of \$12. To receive a copy of your practice ice schedule, please include your email address or a legal size, self-addressed, stamped envelope with your Practice Ice Reservation Form.

## VIDEO TAPES / PHOTOGRAPHS

Action photography and podium pictures will be provided by CnS Photography (<http://cnsphotos.dynalias.com>). Videotaping services will not be provided. Hand-held video equipment for personal use will be permitted in the bleacher areas only. Personal video equipment may not be plugged into arena outlets. Flash or artificial lighting is not allowed during the competition. The competition committee reserves the right to restrict personal video taping to your skater's events only. Individual videotaping will be permitted in designated areas only. Only hand-held battery-operated video cameras will be permitted.

## OFFICIAL NOTICES

An official bulletin board will be maintained in the lobby of the ice skating center at 7300 Bellerive in Houston. Competitors and coaches are responsible for periodically checking the bulletin board for schedule changes, important announcements, and/or additional information. Competitors should report to the ice monitor approximately 30 minutes prior to their scheduled event time.

## LIABILITY

**Competitors, Parents, Coaches and Officials should read Part Two rule #3222 of The 2010 Official U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook carefully.** U.S. Figure Skating, the Iceland Figure Skating Club, Officials of the Iceland Figure Skating Club, Competition Officials, and the ice skating center at 7300 Bellerive in Houston shall be held harmless from any loss, damage, and/or injury that may be sustained by anyone in any manner while participating in any activities of this competition. Your signature on the entry form indicates your acceptance of this stipulation.

## COMPETITION EVENTS

Requirements are based upon test status and age as of the entry deadline (December 19, 2009). Events will follow the guidelines of **the 2008 Official U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook for the 2009-2010 competitive season**.

## Age Categories

The following age categories apply to all singles events: All age categories may be divided or combined depending on the number of registrants; there must be two (2) or more entries to hold an event. **Proof of age is required for all events.** A copy of a birth certificate, passport, driver's license or similar proof of age is considered acceptable, but the Competition Committee reserves the right to require additional documentation. The Young Adult age category applies to most events; however, in Dance competitions, at least one competitor must be 21 years of age or older.

## Composition of Events

### FREE SKATING

#### GENERAL:

Event level is based on age and test level as listed below. Adult program times are maximum times. There is no deduction for programs that are shorter in length. Well Balanced Program rules as defined in the US Figure Skating rulebook will apply unless otherwise noted.

#### SINGLES FREESKATING EVENTS:

Skaters may compete at one level higher than their test level regardless of age. Well Balanced Program and Test requirements are defined in US Figure Skating rules 3730-3806 will apply for all events except for Beginner Free Skate.

#### PAIRS FREESKATING EVENTS:

Skaters may compete at one level higher than the test level of the lowest partner. Well Balanced Program and Test requirements are defined in US Figure Skating rules 4110-4125.

## DANCE

### GENERAL:

Event level is based on age and test level as listed below. In partner dance events at least one partner must be 21 years old. The compulsory dances selected are the first round dances. Test and age requirements, first round dances, and the Free Dance requirements are defined in rules 4450-4506. Skaters qualifying for Masters dance should enter the Gold events. The number of sequences of the dance to be skated is defined by rule 4231 and noted in parenthesis following the dance name. See US Figure Skating rules 4200-4272 for further information on dance events including Compulsory Dance and Free Dance. Free Dance and Compulsory Dance (Couples Dance) are separate events and may be entered separately.

### COUPLES DANCE EVENTS:

This is a combined event with final placement determined by the results of both dances. Dances will be skated in the order listed. Skaters may compete at one level higher than the test level of the lowest partner (i.e. if one partner has passed 1 Pre-Silver dance and the other partner has passed 1 Bronze dance they may skate up to Pre-Silver. If both have passed 1 Pre-Silver dance, they may skate up to Silver).

### FREE DANCE EVENTS:

This event is open to couples meeting the test requirements for the Gold or Pre-Gold Couples Dance Event. The content of the Free Dance is governed by rule 4462 and by extension rules 4270-4272. The maximum time is 3:10. There is no penalty for programs that are shorter in length.

### SOLO DANCE EVENTS:

Competitors in the Solo Dance events may compete at the test level that he or she has partially tested or completed. The number of patterns to be skated is two. The dances shall all be started towards the judges. The dances are the second round compulsory dances or the first round dances where the second round is an original dance.

## OTHER EVENTS

### GENERAL:

Event level is based on age and test level as listed below. Skaters may compete up one level.

### COMPULSORY MOVES EVENTS:

Moves must be performed without music and in any order with connecting steps necessary to link the various moves together. Compulsory moves shall use ½ ice surface except for Gold/Masters, which shall use full ice. Mandatory deductions will be taken for unlisted or additional elements such as jump or spin repetitions or unsuccessfully executed moves.

### SPINS ONLY EVENTS:

Spins must be skated exactly as stated but may be skated in any order. Connecting steps may be used but will not affect scoring. All spin events are skated without music on ½ ice surface.

**JUMPS ONLY EVENTS:**

Jumps must be skated exactly as stated and in the order stated. Connecting steps may be used but will not affect scoring. All jump events are skated without music on ½ ice surface except for Gold/Masters, which is skated on full ice.

**INTERPRETIVE EVENTS:**

These events are broken down by age and test level as defined below.

**Scoring:** Young Adult, Adult, and Masters Interpretive Free Skating shall consist of a variety of skating moves and elements selected for their value in enhancing the skater's interpretation of the music he or she has chosen. Axels and double jumps will not be permitted. Costumes that enhance the performance by appropriately reflecting the character of the music, thereby enhancing the theme, will be considered in the judging. Props on the ice will not be permitted.

Two marks will be given by the judges, the first for **Skating Technique** and the second for **Presentation**.

In marking **Skating Technique**, these aspects will be considered: the ease, flow, glide, sureness, power, and depth of edges; the ability to vary the speed and direction of the skating; the variety of expressive and innovative moves; the succession of movement within the program; the utilization of space and ice coverage; and style.

In marking **Presentation**, these aspects will be considered: the interpretation of the music and rhythm; the skater's musical timing and understanding of the phrasing of music; the use of the entire body to develop artistic and music expression; creativity; choreography and the art of arranging movements; variations in tempo, tension, emotion, and movements; the suitability of the music to the skater; and the internal motivation of movements and expression projected to the audience.

**Music** -- Vocal music is permitted. Check each level for maximum times.

**Notes:**

Skaters placing fourth and higher in preliminary and higher artistic/showcase/interpretive solo events, including adult events, will be qualified to enter the next National Showcase. National Showcase contestants must also be qualified by test level. Duets and production ensembles are not required to qualify for National Showcase.
